# Home-school agreement

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## As a school

We will do our best to:

- Support your child's wellbeing and safety by providing a safe, supportive and caring environment
  - Encourage excellent attendance and punctuality, addressing any concerns with parents or carers where necessary

  - Offer opportunities for parents and carers to get involved in school life
  - Communicate between home and school through posts on Class Dojo, newsletters, emails and the school website
  - Respond to communications from parents and carers in a timely manner, following school policies
  - Model and encourage all stakeholders to follow our school values and tenets
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## Parents/carers

I will do my best to:

- Make sure my child attends school every day and on time (with the exception of extreme illness). I will notify the school if my child will be absent
- Make sure my child is dressed in the correct uniform and brings their PE kit to school where necessary
- Support the school to make sure my child maintains a consistently high standard of behaviour
- Encourage my child to try their best, make positive choices and take responsibility for their actions so they can reach their full potential
- Communicate to the school any concerns that I have about my child that may affect their behaviour in school or ability to learn
- Make sure communication with the school is respectful, and that I make every reasonable effort to address my communications to the appropriate member of staff
- Understand that I should communicate with staff during core school hours, and accept that I may not always get an immediate response

- Make sure that my child completes any home learning on time, and raise any issues that my child has with their teachers
- Support my child to be as independent as possible
- Read and follow the school's policies
- Treat all members of the school community with respect, following our school values and behaving in line with our school ethos
- Engage in parent meetings and work in partnership with the school in order to achieve the best outcomes for my child
- Read all communications sent home by the school and respond where necessary

- Try my best to do my work and ask for help if I need it
- Wear the correct school uniform and bring my PE kit to school when I need it
